**Pitch:** Each participant is tested throwing strikes to a designated "Strike Zone" target.

**Hit:** Each youngster hits a ball off a stationary tee for distance and accuracy.



**Run:** Each contestant is timed, starting from second base, touching third then home.

All events are individually scored and converted to a total point score through the use of conversion tables.
