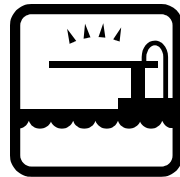

Make your own stamp. Great for thank you cards, Christmas cards, fine art prints, etc.

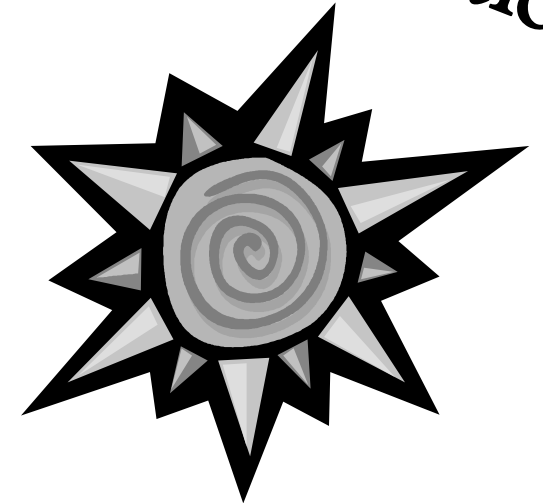
